

ILLEGAL SIGNS

Unsightly and illegal signs are littering our public right of ways and utility poles all across Nashville.

Remember, signs on right of ways and utility poles are illegal. Anyone interested in doing something about this problem may contact the Metro Beautification & Environment Commission. The Commission will send the owner or resident a letter advising them of Nashville's sign laws and requesting that they remove it.

Copies of the letters are sent to NES for those on utility poles; to Codes and Public Works for right of ways; and to the Tennessee Association of REALTORS, Home Builders Association of Middle Tennessee and Greater Nashville Association of REALTORS for real estate signs. Beatification will need to know the location of the sign, whether it is on a utility pole or the public right of way, and the address on the sign.

It is preferred that you send this information to Beautification and let them attempt to have the owner of the sign remove it.
